- Date: Mid to Late March

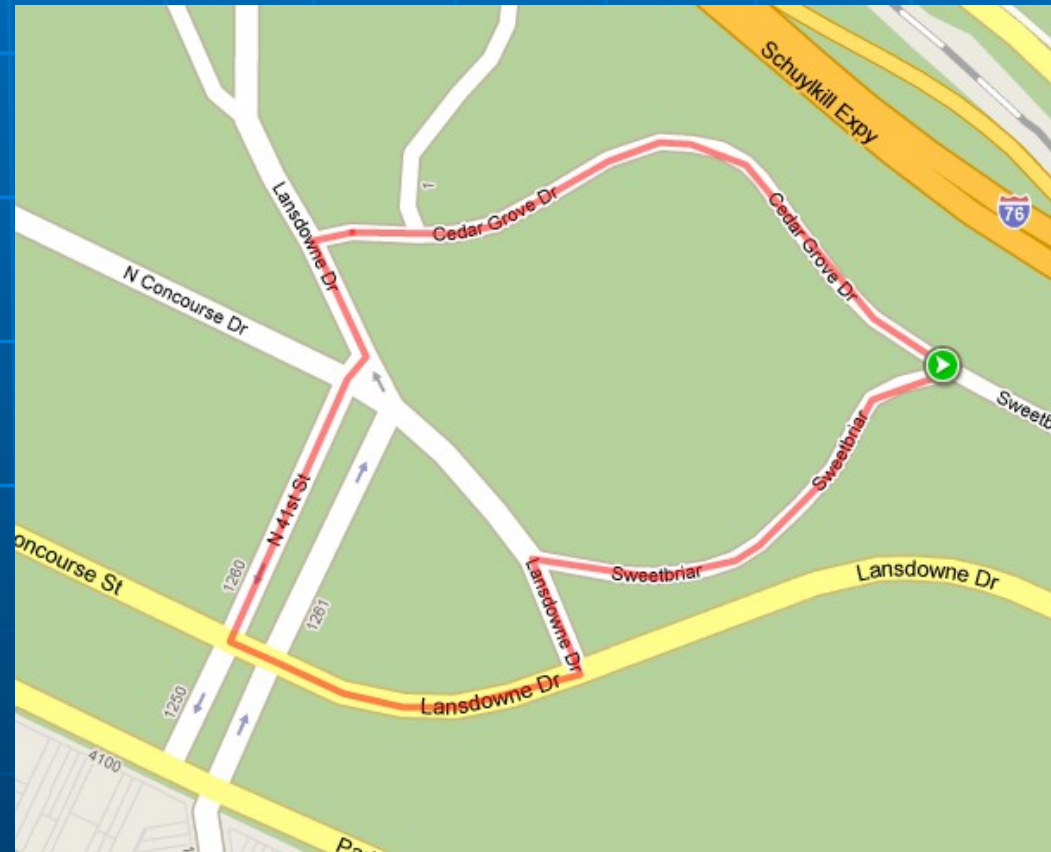
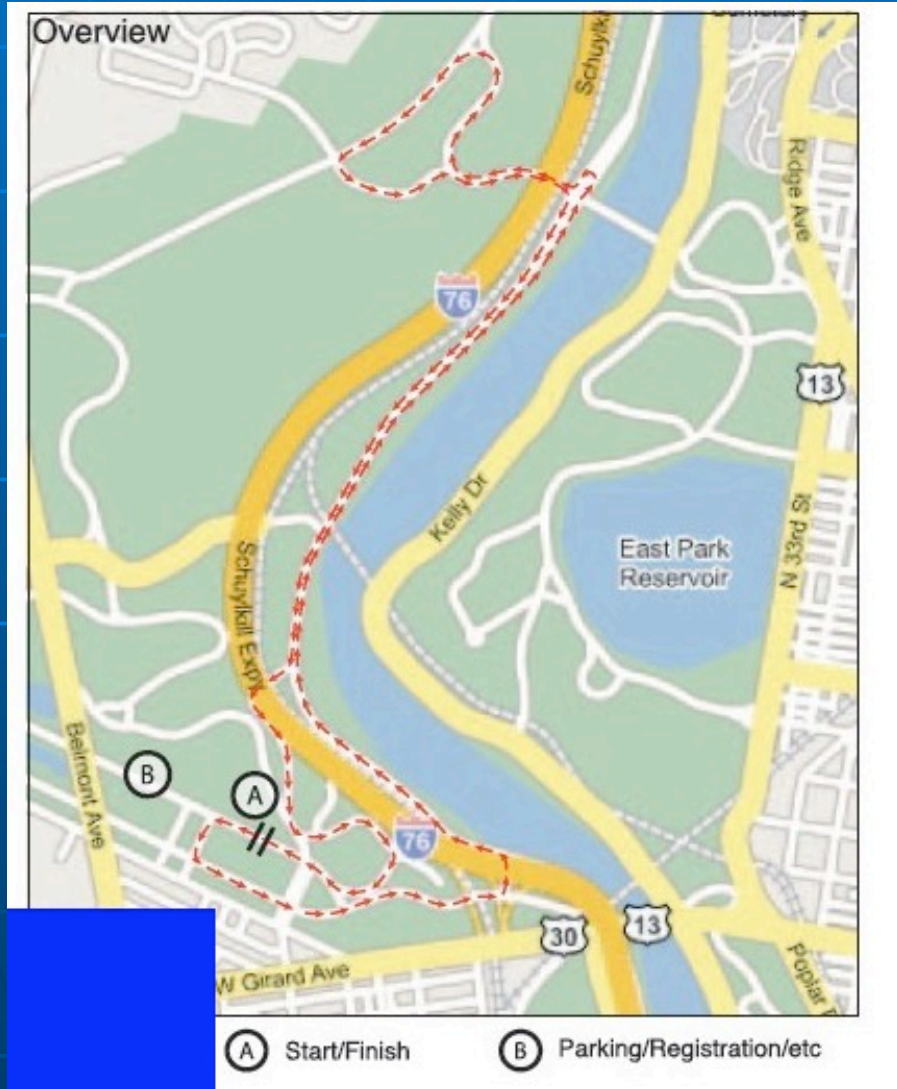
# Race Course

- Same courses that have been used for the past couple of years
  - Circuit: 2 climbs each lap with flat sections
  - Crit: New more technical course
  - TTT: Out and back flat with a climb up to the finish
- Collegiate and some USAC racing, allows for doubling up of races

# Race Course

- No traffic is allowed on the roads during any event, controlled by metal gates with police and marshals at all times
- Saturday – Circuit Race Course
- Sunday – TTT in morning, Crit afterwards
- Neutral support wheel support for circuit and crit (being worked out)
- Large open roads allowing for large fields
