Collegiate fields are open only to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. In addition, new non-collegiate women racers with 1-day or first time Category 4 licenses may enter Collegiate Women's Intro fields. USA Cycling licenses available for sale on-site. Consult the ECCC website at <http://collegiatecycling.org/eccc> for more information on categories, eligibility, licensing, and other general questions.

Registration Fees: Individual Time Trial - \$10, Criterium - \$20.

Pre-Registration is available on-line at BikeReg.com, where service charges might apply. Registrations not received before 5pm on April 10th will incur a \$5 per rider per event late fee. Large ECCC Teams may submit a spreadsheet with the following information: Rider Name, USAC License Number, Race Category and Races being entered for each rider. This spreadsheet must be sent to eccc.road@gmail.com and received by April 10th at 5pm in order to avoid a \$5 late registration fee per rider per event.

Registration is located at the ITT start near Ledyard Canoe Club (where Route 10A meets Tuck Drive) and at the Criterium start/finish on Webster Avenue across from Phi Delta fraternity house and it opens 1 hour before the start of the first scheduled race and ends 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Promoter is not required to refund pre-registration in an event of an unforeseen cancellation.

Medical: Dartmouth EMS on site for all races. The nearest hospital for the race is Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center (1 Medical Center Dr, Lebanon, NH 03755, 603-650-5000.)

Contact the host housing coordinator Rose Long at roselong21@gmail.com with any questions. All host housing recipients are required to marshal during the weekend's races.

Directions to ITT Start:

From I-91 North or South: Take Exit 13 for Norwich, VT / Hanover, NH. Turn on to S Main Street to drive east toward the Connecticut River. Cross the river on the Ledyard Bridge (Rt.10A) and make an immediate left turn in to the Ledyard Canoe Club parking area.

From 1-89 North or South: Take the exit for 1-91 North. After 5 miles, take Exit 13 for Norwich, VT / Hanover, NH. See directions above.

Directions from ITT to Criterium Parking:

Turn left out of the parking area on to West Wheelock Street / Rt.10A. Drive up the hill and turn left at the second stop light (Park Street / Rt.120). At the next stop light, drive straight to enter Dewey Parking Lot.

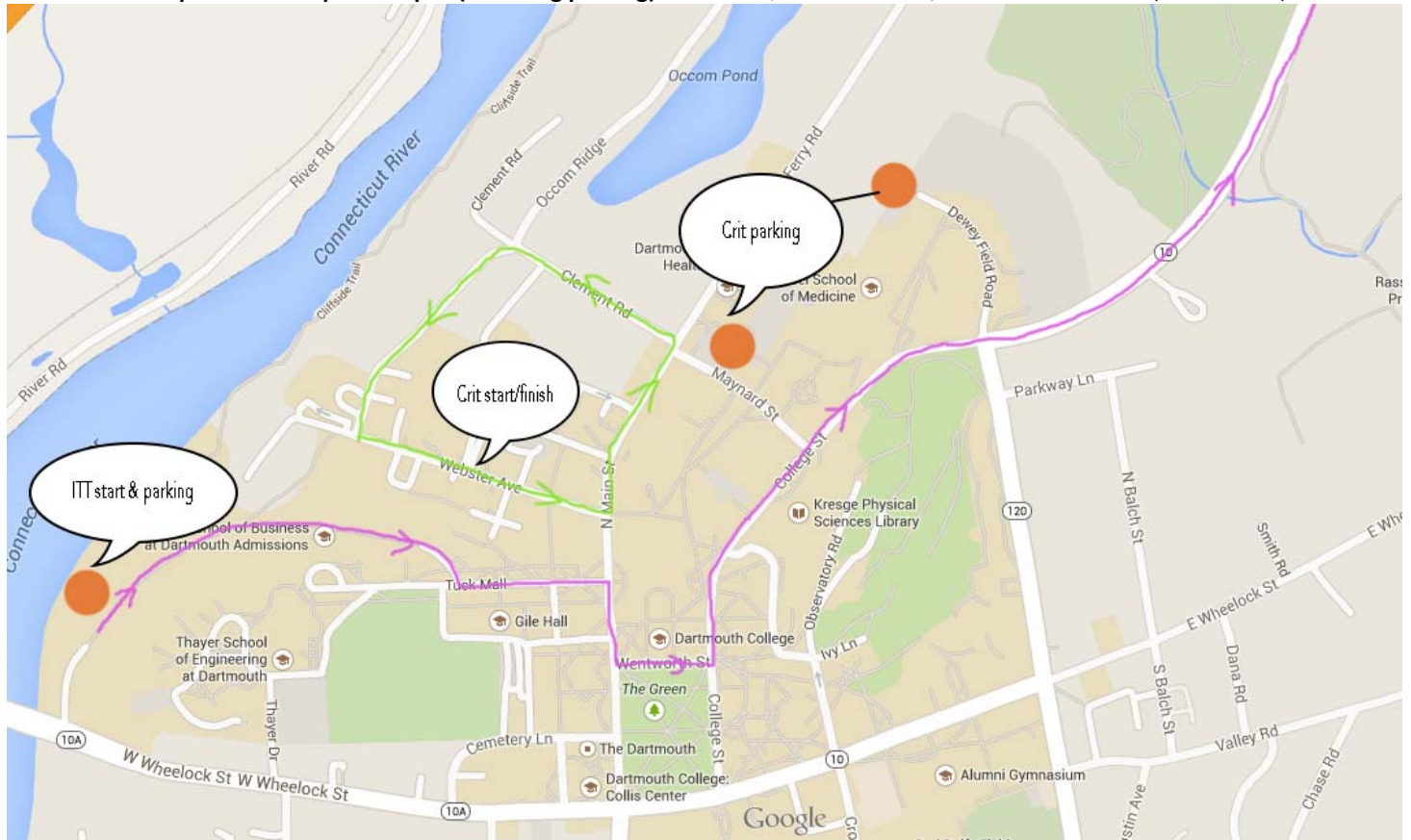
