Collegiate fields are open only to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. In addition, new non-collegiate women racers with 1-day or first time Category 4 licenses may enter Collegiate Women's Intro fields. USA Cycling licenses available for sale on-site. Registration Fees: Team Time Trial - \$25/team, Road Race - \$20.

Pre-Registration is available on-line at BikeReg.com, where service charges might apply. Registrations not received before 5pm on March 20th will incur a \$5 per rider per event late fee. Large ECCC Teams may submit a spreadsheet with the following information: Rider Name, USAC License Number, Race Category and Races being entered for each rider. This spreadsheet must be sent to eccc.road@gmail.com and received by March 20th at 5pm in order to avoid a \$5 late registration fee per rider per event.

Registration is located at the Parker School parking lot (92 Parker School Road, Pittstown, NY 12094), and it opens 1 hour before the start of the first scheduled race and ends 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Promoter is not required to refund pre-registration in an event of an unforeseen cancellation.

Directions:

GPS: 92 Parker School Road, Pittstown, NY 12094

Traveling North on I-87:

- Take EXIT 23 to merge onto I-787 N toward Downtown Albany/Troy/Rensselaer.
- Take EXIT 9E to merge onto RT-7 toward Troy/Bennington.
- Take sharp right onto Parker School Rd. Parking is a quarter mile down the road on the left.

Traveling South on I-87:

- Take EXIT 7 to merge onto RT-7 towards Troy/Cohoes.
- Take sharp right onto Parker School Rd. Parking is a quarter mile down the road on the left.

Traveling East on I-90:

- Take EXIT 1N to merge onto I-87 N. Take EXIT 7 and merge onto RT-7 towards Troy/Cohoes.
- Take sharp right onto Parker School Rd. Parking is a quarter mile down the road on the left.

Traveling West on I-90:

- Take EXIT B3 onto RT-22 toward Austerlitz/New Lebanon.
- Turn right onto RT-22. Turn right onto US-20/Columbia Pike/RT-22.
- Turn slight left onto RT-22.
- Turn left onto RT-7.
- Turn slight left onto Parker School Rd. Parking is a quarter mile down the road on the left.

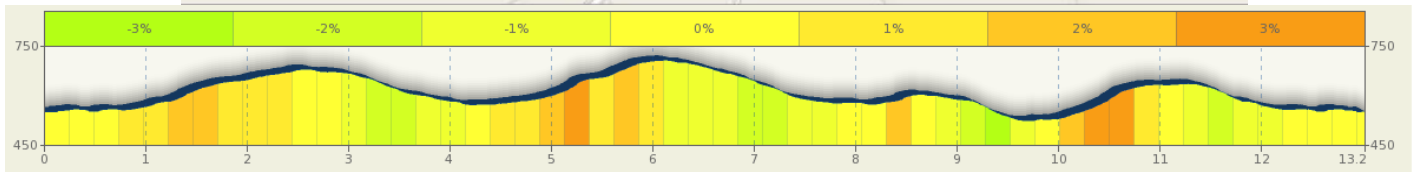
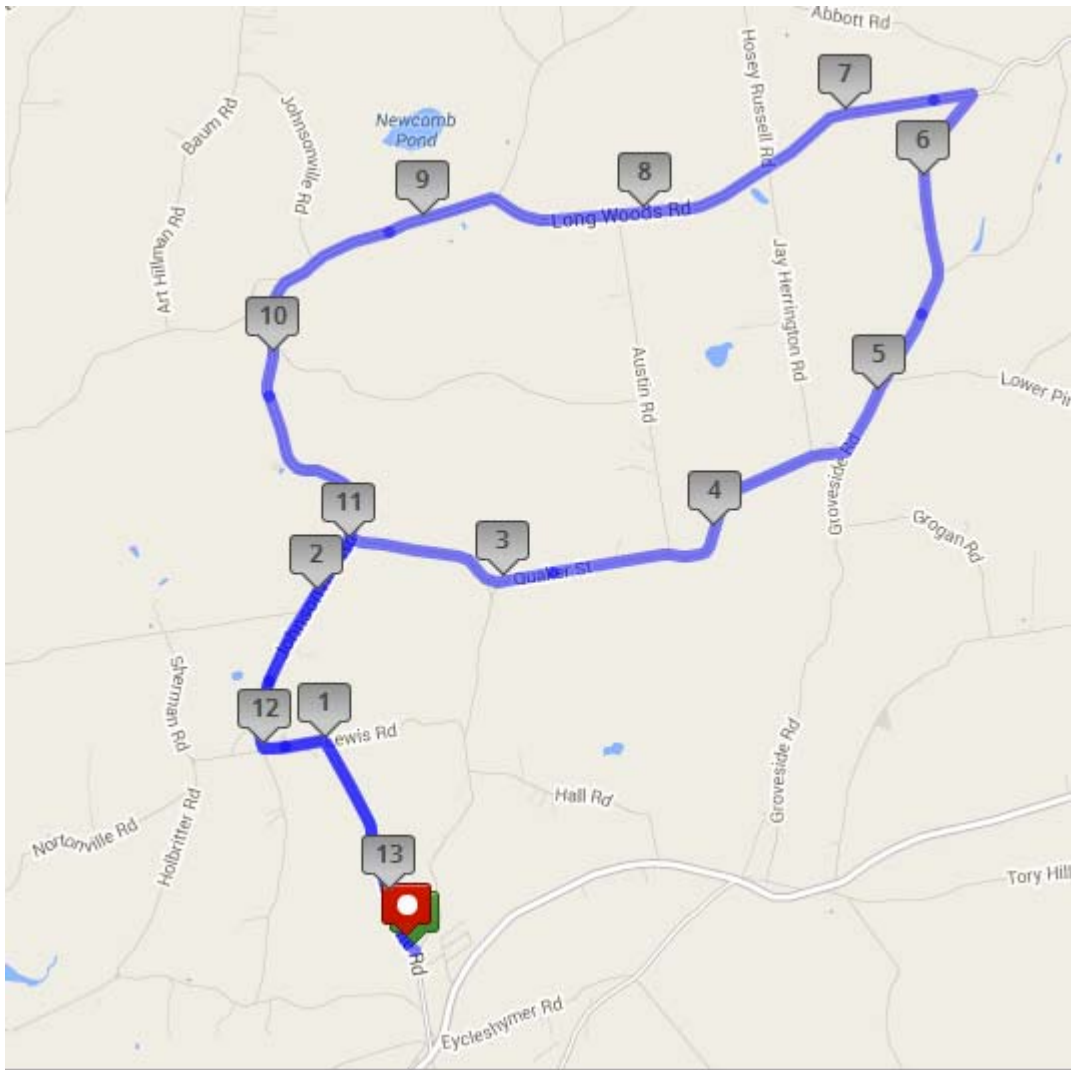

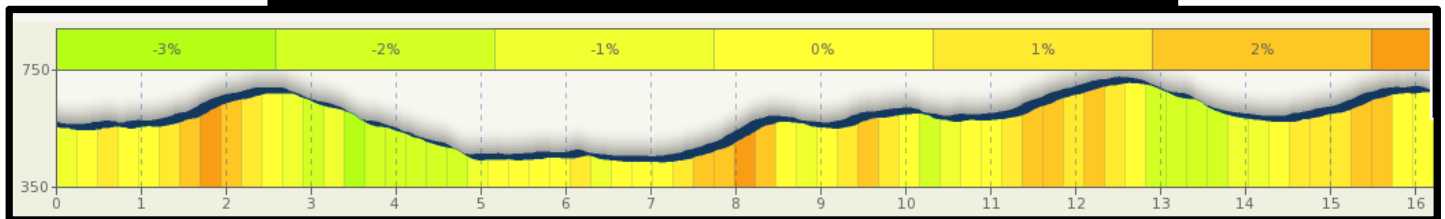
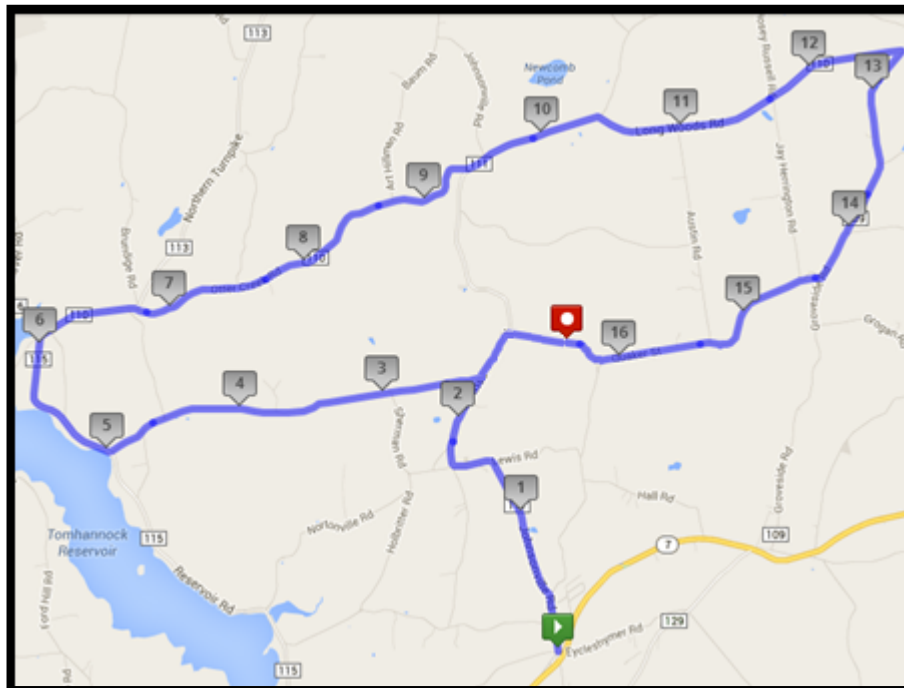
TTT Race Course Description: A 13 mile course with 800 feet of climbing. This course will run counterclockwise through the farmland of Pittstown NY. Expect all 13 miles to feature rolling hills. No aero equipment (USAC mass start legal only) allowed.

Road Race Course Description: 15 mile loop with a 2 mile start chute. Once on the loop, riders will proceed clockwise. The loop features a long gradual downhill towards the reservoir, followed by rolling terrain through farmland, and finishing with a gradual uphill finish. While there are no large stand-alone climbs, this course is not to be underestimated, as it features over 1200 feet of climbing per lap.
