Collegiate fields are open only to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. In addition, new non-collegiate women racers with 1-day or first time Category 4 licenses may enter Collegiate Women's Intro fields. USA Cycling licenses available for sale on-site. Registration Fees: Collegiate Races - \$20; USAC Races - \$40.

USAC Race Prize List: \$1500/15 places

Pre-Registration is available on-line at BikeReg.com, where service charges might apply. Registrations not received before 5pm on April 10th will incur a \$5 per rider per event late fee. Large ECCC Teams may submit a spreadsheet with the following information: Rider Name, USAC License Number, Race Category and Races being entered for each rider. This spreadsheet must be sent to eccc.road@gmail.com and received by April 10th at 5pm in order to avoid a \$5 late registration fee per rider per event. Registration is located at Charlotte Central School. It opens 1 hour before the start of the first scheduled race and ends 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Promoter is not required to refund pre-registration in an event of an unforeseen cancellation.

Directions to Start:

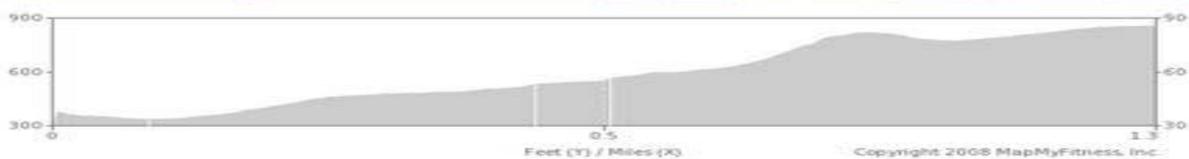
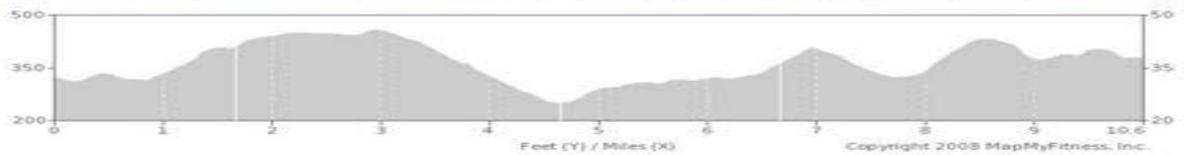
From West: I-87 to Exit 28. NY 74 to Ticonderoga. North on NY 9N/22 to NY 185 east. Once over the bridge and in VT, bear left onto VT 17 west to Addison. North on VT 22A to Vergennes. North on US 7 to Church Hill Rd east (opposite direction of VT F-5). At stop, bear right onto Hinesburg Rd; school is on right.

From East: I-89 to Exit 12. VT 2A south to VT 116 south to Hinesburg. East on Charlotte Rd (3rd light in town - across from IGA Market) to school on left (approx 5 miles).

Race Course Description and Map: The race route will consist of a 10.6 mile undulating circuit that each field will traverse a set amount of times. The final circuit will include a sharp right hand turn into a final 1.2 mile finishing climb with a 9.7 % average gradient and maximum gradients upwards of 30 %.
