\* Beginners Clinic will take approximately 1 hour. In addition to collegiate cyclists, new non-collegiate racers with 1-day or first time Category 5 (men)/Category 4 (women) licenses may enter Beginners Clinic and Men's E/Women's D criterium race respectively.

Collegiate fields are open only to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. USA Cycling licenses available for sale on-site. Consult the ECCC website at <http://collegiatecycling.org/eccc> for more information on categories, eligibility, licensing, and other general questions.

**Registration Fees:** All Team Time Trial - \$25/team; USAC ITT - \$15; Road Race - \$25; ECCC Criterium - \$20; USAC Criterium - \$35; Beginners Clinic - \$20.

### USAC Race Information:

**Time Trial Prize List:** Open TTT - medals to the winning team, Open ITT - medals/3 places. **Criterium Prize List:** Men 1/2/3 - \$250/5 places, Men 4/5 - medals/3 places, Women 3/4 - \$150/3 places. One-day licenses are available for \$10 and are valid for a single day of racing. One-day licenses may only be purchased by Category 5 Men and Category 4 Women, for use in races open to those categories. Entry Fee for USAC categories includes NEBRA Rider Surcharge of \$1 and USA Cycling Insurance Surcharge of \$3.75.

Pre-Registration is available on-line at BikeReg.com, where service charges might apply. Registrations not received before 5pm on April 21<sup>st</sup> will incur a \$5 per rider per event late fee. Large ECCC Teams may submit a spreadsheet with the following information: Rider Name, USAC License Number, Race Category and Races being entered for each rider. This spreadsheet must be sent to [eccc.road@gmail.com](mailto:eccc.road@gmail.com) and received by April 21<sup>st</sup> at 5pm in order to avoid a \$5 late registration fee per rider per event.

Registration is located near finish line for all races. It opens 1 hour before the start of the first scheduled race and ends 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Promoter is not required to refund pre-registration in an event of an unforeseen cancellation.

**Medical:** A stand-by ambulance will be present for the road race, along with on-course EMTs. The nearest hospital for the weekend is Baystate Franklin Medical Center, 164 High St, Greenfield, MA, 413-773-0211.

### Directions to TTT/ITT/Road Race:

**GPS/Google:** 98 Winchester Rd, Warwick, MA

I-91 to Exit 28A. Follow signs for route 10 north. At interchange with route 63, take a left following 10/63 north. In 3/4 of a mile, turn right onto Warwick Rd. In 5 1/4 miles, turn left onto Leland Hill Rd, then a left at the end of the road onto Flower Hill Rd. At the end of Flower Hill, turn right onto Winchester Rd (route 78 south) and look for parking signs at Mt. Grace State Forest entrance.

**GPS/Google:** Unity Park, Turner Falls, MA

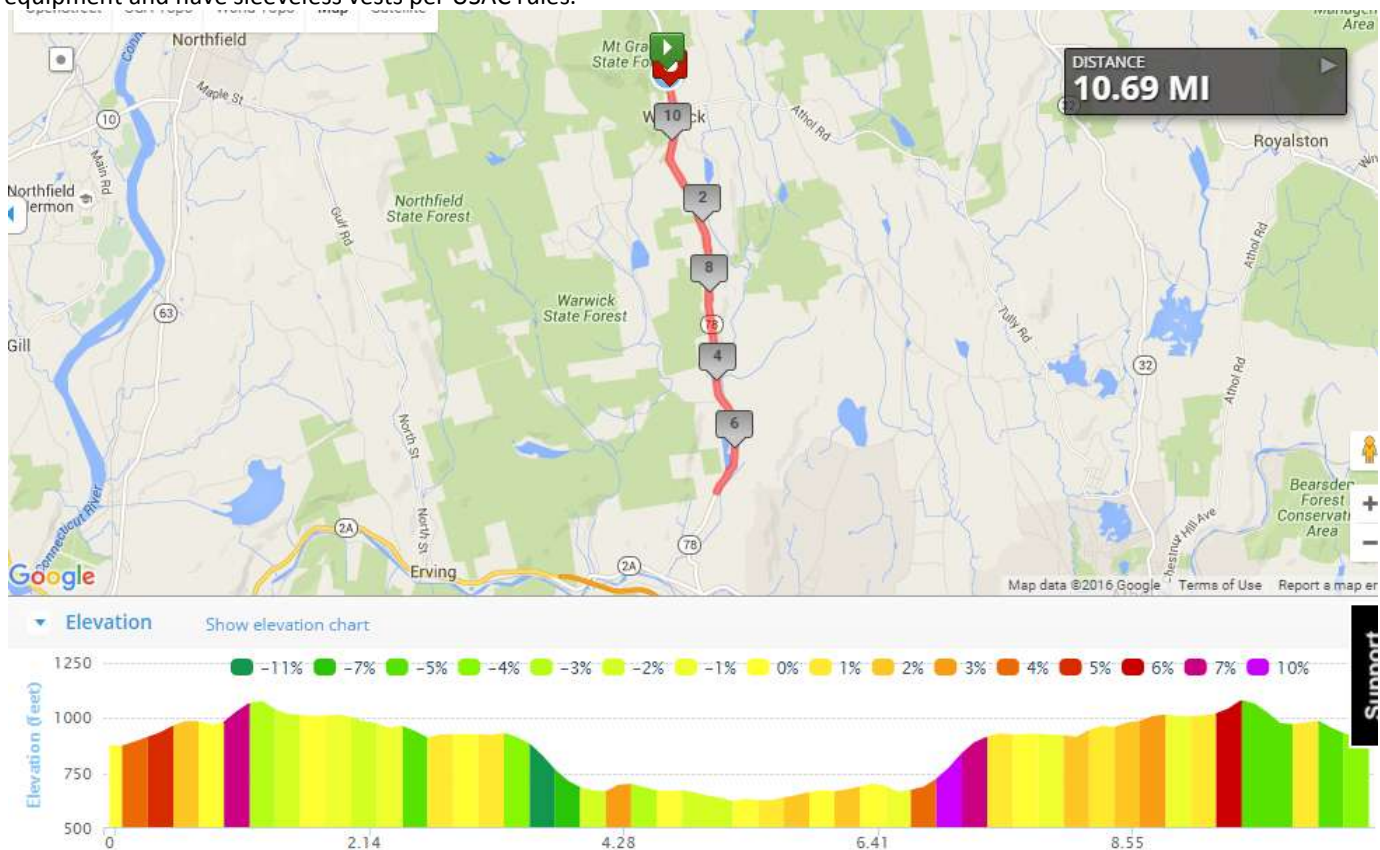
I-91 to Exit 27 and proceed east on route 2 for 2 1/2 miles. Take a right onto Main St at light and go over the bridge into town. 1st left is 1st St, and look for parking signs.

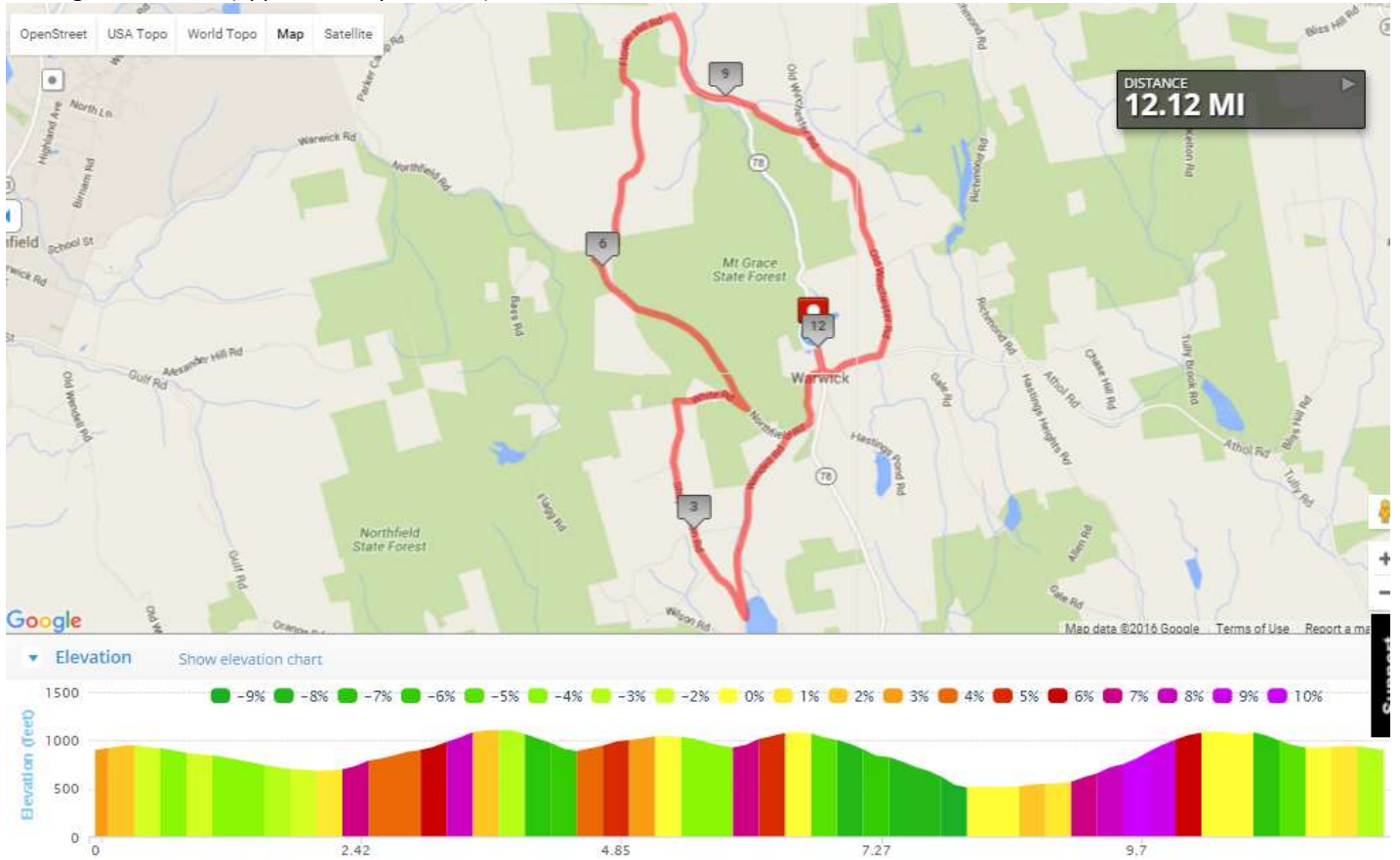
### TTT/ITT Race Course Description:

11 mile out and back course, mostly rolling hills with one punchy climb and one steady climb. Teams and individuals will be leaving in 30 second intervals. **No aero equipment (USAC mass start legal only) allowed in collegiate races.** USAC Open races may use aero equipment and have sleeveless vests per USAC rules.



### Road Race Course Description:

A 12 mile loop with 2 climbs and lots of undulation. No rest for the weary on this very pretty but very difficult course. Neutral start to village of Warwick (approximately 1/4 mile).



**criterium Race Course Description:**

.75 mile loop, 3-turn course. Course will test the sprinting legs and the climbing legs, as the near 180 degree turn is on top of a short, but steep hill. Finish line will be on the flats along the Connecticut River next to Unity Park.
