Individual Time Trial – Hill Climb: Saturday March 27th 2010

Course: The course is 3.7-miles long starting at the West entrance of the Colorado National Monument. The course will begin to climb a series of switchbacks that get gradually steeper until the finishing straights. The course gains about 1,071 feet in elevation and goes through 2 rock tunnels.

Directions: Parking and registration will be at Rim Rock Adventures (RAA) at 927 Highway 340 (Broadway); Take Exit 19 (Fruita) off I-70 and turn left, go 1.3 miles South. RRA is on the left. Registration will be done on a first come first served basis and will be from 8am-10:30am. It is under a 10 minute ride from registration to the start line. The first rider will start at **9am**

* All bicycle riders must be equipped with lights visible from the front and rear for safe passage through the tunnels. Bicyclists must use a white light that is visible from at least 500 feet to the front and a red light that is seen from at least 200 feet from the rear. (Please bring your own lights if you have them otherwise they will be supplied for you at the start line)

Twilight Criterium: Saturday, March 27th 2010

Course: The course is a very technical .9 mile 32 foot wide loop located at the Grand Junction Motor Speedway.

Directions: From Grand Junction travel East down Patterson Rd/F Road until turning left (north) on 29 Rd. Stay on 29Rd until it intersects the I-70 frontage road and follow to the speedway at 3030 N. I-70 Frontage Road.

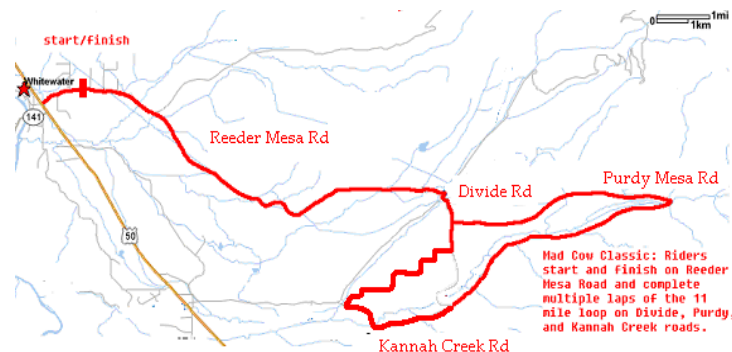

Road Race: Sunday, March 28th 2010

Course: The start/finish line is on Reeder Mesa Road 2 miles from Hwy 50 at Whitewater. The route is 8 miles out on Reeder Mesa to the loop on Purdy Mesa. Riders will complete multiple laps of this 11-mile loop before retracing the original 8 miles back on Reeder Mesa to the finish line. Feed zone is at the beginning of the lap (intersection of Purdy and Divide). No wheel support will be provided.

Directions: For the road race take Hwy 50 south from Grand Junction towards Delta. At Whitewater turn left off of Hwy 50 onto Reeder Mesa Road continue 2 miles to parking and start of the road race. For the time trial continue on Hwy 50 3 miles south of Whitewater and turn left on Kannah Creek Rd (look for sign to Land's End). Go 3 miles up Kannah Creek Rd to the intersection with Land's End and Purdy Mesa. For the criterium take I-70 west to exit 19 for Fruita, turn right for downtown, parking and the course.
