

WSC Mountain Bike Race 2011

Hosted by WSC Cycling

October 1 – 2, 2011

Held Under USA Cycling Permit

Registration: Registration will be at the Hartman Rocks base parking lot and will close 30 minutes before the start of each category.

Entry Fees: \$20 for the first race, \$15 each for the 2nd and 3rd, 4th race free . There will be open categories in XC, DH, and Air DH. The open riders will be sent after the collegiate riders on each race.

Prizes: 75% Payback for USAC Open Categories, (all open entry fees will be pooled and split): 1st – 35%, 2nd – 25%, 3rd – 15%

Location Directions: All races except for the Air DH will be held at Hartman Rocks recreation area, The Air DH will be held behind the WSC Campus on a new flow/jump trail. The new flow/jump is located directly Northeast of the Mountaineer Bowl Stadium. There will parking available for the Air DH down Athletic Drive, past the maintenance buildings on the Northwest end of campus. See the campus map below for details.

From Denver: Head south on US 285 towards Fairplay, at Buena Vista head left onto US-285 S, turn right onto US 50 W at Poncha Springs, over Monarch Pass to Gunnison. Drive through Gunnison and turn left onto W Airport Rd/Co Rd 38, continue to follow Co Rd 38. Look for large Hartman Rocks sign on right.

From Montrose: Stay on US 50 E, past Blue Mesa reservoir to Gunnison, CO. Turn right onto W Airport Rd/Co Rd 38, continue to follow Co Rd 38. Look for large Hartman Rocks sign on right.

Lodging: Camping is free at Hartman Rocks, there are many campsites up kill hill (west on CO Road 32C) from the Hartman Rocks base parking lot. Camping is also available at the Gunnison KOA at \$6.00 per person per night. Make reservations for the KOA at (800) 562-1248. There will also be an empty campus building, the Ophir Apartments, available for teams to stay in. There will be minimal charges to cover our costs, but the rooms will have running water, bathrooms and showers. See the campus map below for location of the Ophir Apartments.

Course Description:

Saturday:

- STXC: A fast loop at the base of Hartmans. Up Tugs and down Collarbone.

- Air DH: A Grand Opening of the new flow/jump trail built directly behind WSC campus. Riders sent in one minute intervals.

Sunday:

- XC: See map below for details on men's and women's A, B, and C classes.
- DH: The Notch, a technical descent to Collarbone, a fast bermed trail. Riders sent in one minute intervals.

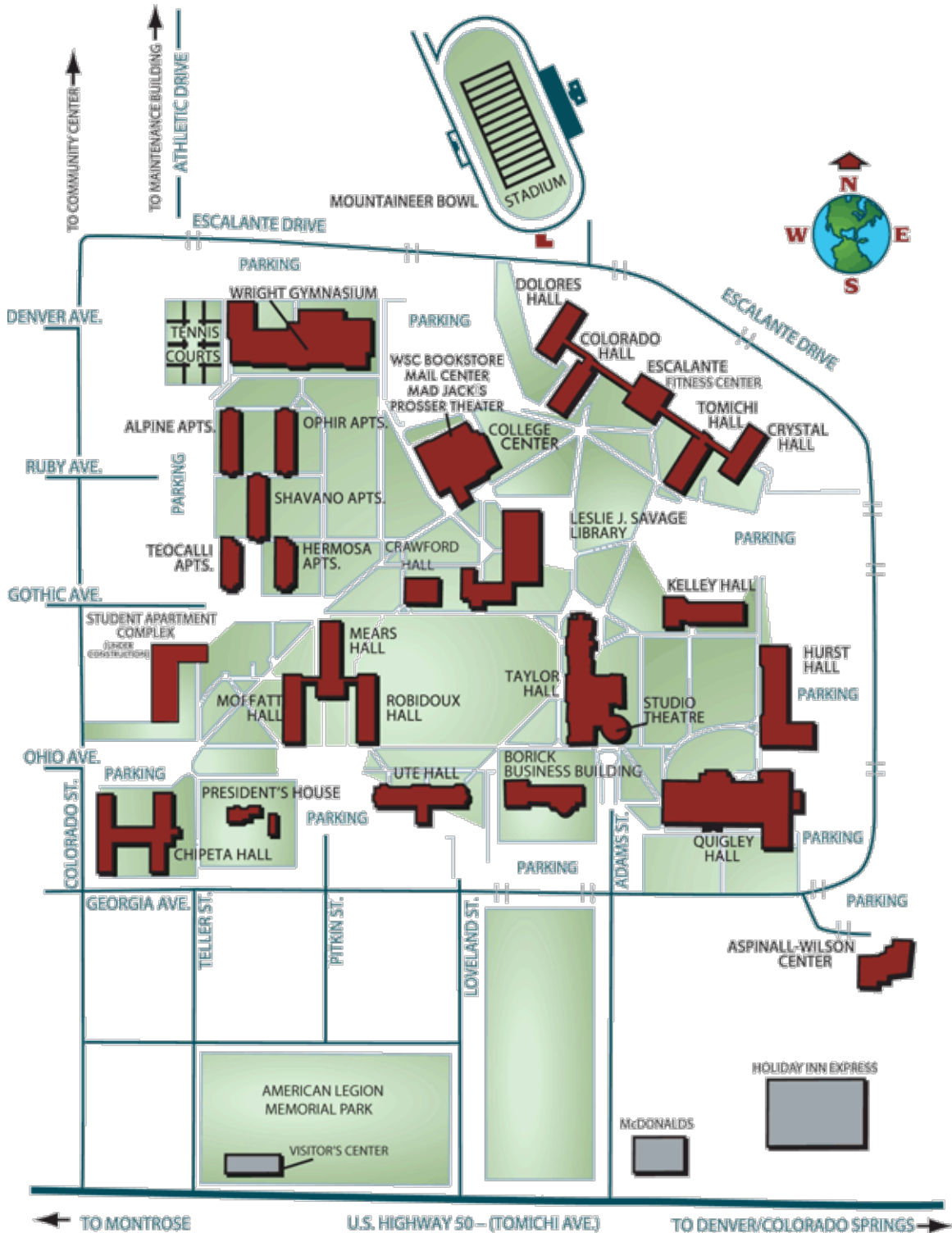
