

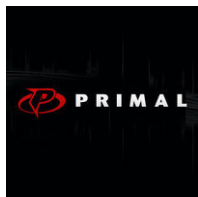

General Information:

- USAC rules will govern all races
- * Race Registration will begin at 9:30 AM. You may register up to 15 minutes before the start of each race.
- * Tornado Cross is a USAC sanctioned event.
- * All racers must present a valid USAC racing license. Unlicensed riders will be required to purchase a \$10.00 "one day license", and be placed in the CX 4 men or Women.
- * All riders will be required to complete and sign a "standard athlete's entry release form".
- * Entry fee includes \$3 USAC insurance surcharge
- * Entry fee includes \$1 per race TBRA surcharge
- * All races will take place rain or shine
- * All riders must wear ANSI approved helmets.
- * Bar ends must be removed from mountain bikes.
- * No refunds of entry fees.
- * Organizer reserves right to combine fields, fields with fewer than four riders may be combined or canceled.
- * Protest period will be 15 minutes after results are posted.

Course & Race Information

Tornado CX will be another challenging course on the campus of King College. Running through the woods trail and skirting both sides of the lake before making the climb up the hill toward the main entrance. Multiple switchbacks and a couple of short steep climbs will have everyone ready for the brief descent back toward the Student Center Complex and the start/finish area.

The race sponsors include Primalwear, Swiftwick and Food City in addition to huge support from our local bike shops Mountain Sports, Piney Flats Cycles and Highlands Ski and Outdoors.

Registration will take place in the foyer of the Student Center Complex and all facilities will be open for riders and spectators to use. That means no portable toilets and a warm, dry place to watch the race in case of poor weather. King's athletic training staff will be on site to handle any medical issues. Some concessions will also be available for purchase.

I-26 W from Johnson City/Asheville:

Take exit 35A to merge onto N Roan St/US-11e/US-19W 0.9 mi, Slight right at TN-34/US-11e/US-19W, Continue to follow TN-34/US-11e 12.4 mi Take the TN-394/County Hwy-390 exit toward Bluff City/Blountville0.3 mi. Turn right at Bluff City Rd/TN-394Continue to follow TN-394 2.1 mi Continue on Bristol Beltway/TN-345.4 mi, Turn left at TN-34/TN-421/US-421Continue to follow TN-34/US-4211.7 mi, Turn right at E Cedar St0.7 mi Turn left at Tadlock Rd

I-81 from Knoxville:

Take exit 1 for US-421 toward Bristol/Gate City/US-58 0.4 mi, Keep right at the fork, and follow signs for Bristol and merge onto Gate City Hwy/US-421,1.0mi, Slight left at US-421 Entering Tennessee 262 ft, Slight left at W State Slight left to stay on W State St, Slight right to stay on W State St Continue straight to stay on W State St , Slight left at State St, Continue straight to stay on State St Slight right to stay on State St 1.1 mi, Continue to King College

I-81 from Abingdon:

Take exit 3 to merge onto I-381 S toward Bristol, 1.7 mi Continue on Commonwealth Ave, Entering Tennessee 1.2 mi Turn left at State St 0.4 mi Slight left to stay on State St 23 ft Continue straight to stay on State St 20 ft Slight right to stay on State St 1.1 mi Continue on to King College
